Profit from the day was still just over \$2,000 which will fund two scholarships to the Class of 2024, so the day was considered a success!

Designer Purse Bingo Committee Report

The annual Designer Purse Bingo event is set to be held Tuesday, September 26, 2023 at 6:30pm. This year's venue will be the Top Eliminator Club due to the ability to increase the number of participants. As of September 14th, we have sold 433 tickets. This is \$6,120 more than last year in ticket sales. The committee is hoping for a sellout at 498 tickets (which would be another \$2,640 in ticket revenue and 66 more people there to spend money). All aspects of the event have been completed with the exception of gathering of Mystery Bag items. The committee is still looking to secure 100 Mystery Bags for this year's event.
