IN 2023, OVER \$94,000 WAS GIVEN BACK TO THE STAFF AND STUDENTS OF THE BROWNSBURG COMMUNITY SCHOOLS IN THE FORM OF GRANTS TO ENHANCE THEIR EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCES. THESE PROJECTS AND OPPORTUNITIES WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE WITHOUT YOUR GIFTS TO THE BROWNSBURG EDUCATION FOUNDATION.

Young Women of Purpose

This grant purchased the Young Women of Purpose curriculum that allows 50-60 young women to participate in this character development program at each middle school. The Young Women of Purpose program positively impacts the student of the Brownsburg Schools by providing these young women an opportunity to develop confidence and leadership skills to prepare for life's challenges. Girls meet during their 1st period SEEK class and learn study skills, relaxation skills, public speaking skills and other valuable skills to help them be successful both in and out of the classroom. They also participate in service projects to make their schools and community a better place.



Engaging, Fun and Relevant Technology

This grant purchased Amazon Fire tablets to use in conjunction with Spheros robots purchased previously by BEF for a high school class (that were no longer in use) so that middle school students can practice coding and problem solving. By providing more devices for students to engage in hands-on learning experiences, their interest in engineering and technology is sparked, creating a pathway for the students to be more prepared for the computer science curriculum at the high school. Allowing the students to have exposure to these education-friendly robots and devices enhances the curriculum and keeps the course fresh and exciting for all students.



Pre-Writing Proficiency

This grant provides simple supplies like scarves, rhythm sticks and bean bags that create a variety of multiple activities that introduce early childhood learners to the necessary concepts needed prior to writing. The implementation of handwriting concepts such as "big, little", "top, middle, bottom", "up and down" all begin at the preschool and Pre-K levels. If students have these concepts mastered within the early childhood education years, handwriting at the elementary level, specifically kindergarten, will support students for greater academic success.



Scoot and Get Movin'



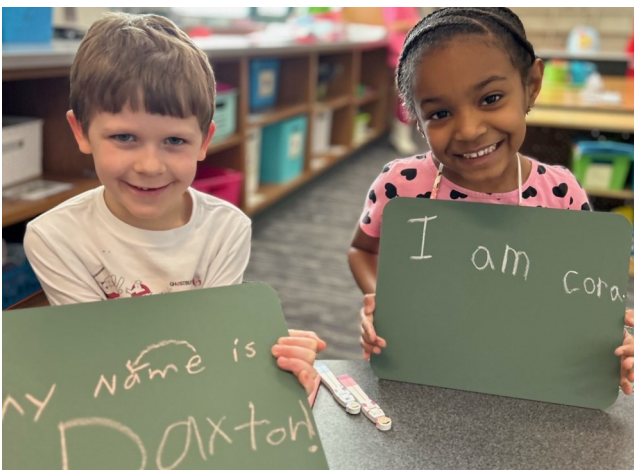
The new interlocking scooters allow an entire class to participate together in scooter activities and games. The interlocking component allows them to be creative, work together, and move together. The 3-wheeled scooters offer fun while working on core strength and dynamic balance and coordinating their movements. The PlasmaCar also offers work on postural control/core strength while seated for those students who do not have the balance yet to be upright on the standing scooter. Students are coming into BECC in large numbers with poor core/postural strength, poor motor-planning, and poor balance and coordination after growing up isolated during COVID. These materials offer different opportunities for students to have fun while working on improving their core strength and learning to balance and to coordinate their bodies while moving and scooting during their gross motor time with friends.

Machining Upgrades

Thanks to this grant, the BHS Robotics Team is able to cut through thicker metals with the stronger, more precise router, and they complete almost all of their part manufacturing in-house, which is what the team has strived to do for quite a few years. The CNC upgrades allow the team to machine more precise parts by being able to finely tune the X, Y, and Z axis on the machine. Previously, robot parts that needed to be very precise had to be outsourced to a waterjet company. Students are thrilled with the increased speed and accuracy with which they can cut metal parts, especially using thicker metals. This allows for a quicker timeline, from creation of parts on the computer to physical parts ready to be used on the robot. This machine can also be shared with the PLTW (Project Lead the Way) classes, and they can benefit from the increased efficiencies as well.



Write or Flight



BCSC occupational therapists have observed a growing trend in fine/visual motor and handwriting deficits. Subjective data shows various reasons for this, one being how students “play” outside the classroom, as technology has replaced the sidewalk chalk and coloring books. Many kindergartners are also entering school with limited or no preschool experience, as the COVID pandemic kept some of them at home in their early years. When these students do not have the opportunity to grasp these skills, they sometimes enter the “flight” phase and writing becomes a negative experience. Through the funding of this project, all students have access to a “Writing Toolbox” with materials to provide students with the foundations for successful handwriting required for academic excellence.

Permanent Grant Projects

Elementary Running Clubs

Third through fifth grade students practice running weekly after school at all eight elementary schools. They begin their time together with a healthy snack, then do warm-ups together before heading out to run. Students also have the opportunity to participate in running meets with other running clubs. Running Clubs give students an opportunity to enjoy time together as a team, set personal goals and learn about ways that they can release stress and maintain a healthy lifestyle.



Purdue Science Express

This project pays for BHS teachers to be trained on various pieces of lab equipment through Purdue University, which then allows them access to over \$4 million worth of research-grade instruments to use in their classrooms throughout the year. Equipment is delivered by Purdue and left at BHS for a week, then picked back up by Purdue and returned to the University. Students have access to many sophisticated pieces of lab equipment that they otherwise would not have the opportunity to use.



Real Men Read



Community members volunteer their time once a month to read to all kindergarten students in the school corporation. Each month, kindergartners get a copy of the book to take home to their families, to continue reading together and to build their home libraries.



Elementary Reading Challenges

Over summer and winter breaks, elementary students are challenged to read each day. This helps maintain and strengthen their literacy skills. All students who complete the reading challenge are then rewarded with a fun activity. Activities include STEM building materials, such as LEGOs, marble runs, KEVA planks and magnetic tiles, purchased by BEF.



Log Cabin Homestead Project

The Brownsburg Education Foundation (BEF) is excited to fund this interactive history experience for all third grade students in the Brownsburg Community School Corporation (BCSC). Each third grade class spends a half day at the cabin immersed in life as a pioneer child.

Built in 1998 as a gift from the Brownsburg Sesquicentennial Committee to the school corporation, this building sat unused for many years. With the help of BCSC administration and your generous gifts, this property has been restored for this hands-on historical visit.

Starting in 2022, BEF also introduced Pioneer Camp during the summer to all exiting third, fourth and fifth grade students for an even more involved experience of what life was like in pioneer days!

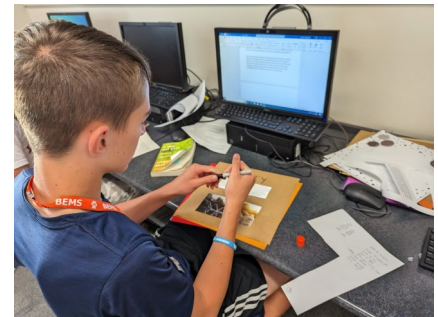

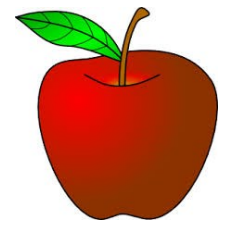
