BEF continues to lead and support the BHS Alumni Hall of Fame project. Typically, each October or November, a group of community members meet to select the BHS Alumni Hall of Fame class. The class is inducted during the BEF Gala in March. The community panel met on November 6th but were unable to select any worthy alumni for the Hall of Fame. Lofty guidelines are set to ensure that each candidate is qualified for induction. After spending much time looking over applications, the panel thought that no candidates met all of the criteria.

Thanks to those BHS staff, students, and community members who gave time to serve on the selection panel.

Finally, the AHOF committee continues to stay in conversation with BCSC administrators concerning the permanent placement/display of the AHOF plaques in the renovated fieldhouse. As this process evolves, we will keep the BEF board informed.

Year-end Campaign

• BEF has gratefully received a \$10,000 from a donor who requested that the gift goes into the endowment but asked if this gift could be used as an incentive for our year-end campaign as a matching gift. Letters and publicity will be shared as such. Official kick-off of year-end campaign will be on #GivingTuesday. Letters will be mailed to donors the week of November 18th or 25th.

Log Cabin Community Day

• We got perfect weather and had a great turnout of over 60 community members. Principals and teachers sharing on Parent Square was helpful as well as the historical display and craft presented by the Brownsburg Public Library.

Current and Ongoing Projects

- 2024 District Excellence Award grant ordering is complete except for a late addition of a SMART board for the Applied Skills class at Brown Elementary. InCredible Award grant ordering is waiting for one teacher to submit her order as well.
- Wrap-up of Log Cabin Homestead project for 2024 including washing of all clothes, costumes and quilts and inventory of supplies so that we are prepared for next year
- Regular meetings with Gala Committee in preparation for this event as well as applying
 online for silent auction donations, merging letters to send to area businesses for donations
 and designing 2025 invitation.
- Revision and updating of 2025 Partnership Opportunities for community businesses
- Visits with current BEF community partners as well as new businesses in Brownsburg to secure involvement for 2025
- Due to the resignation of the development director at the beginning of October, BEF will be looking to fill this position again at the beginning of 2025.

- Complete revision of scholarship platform with migration from Kaleidoscope (budgeted at \$7500/year) to eForm Solutions (\$3550 for the first year and \$2500 or \$2800 going forward depending on the number of applicants we have)
- Classroom visits to observe grants in action and creation of grant summaries to share impact with donors
- Regular collaboration with students from DECA class regarding their BEF marketing project
- Expansion of the Essentials for Excellence Fund to include distributing signs and a link to each school when it is their month to collect items for the BCSC Food Pantry in an effort to make things easier for parents or who would prefer to give a monetary donation.
- Alumni Hall of Fame Selection Committee meeting and administration following meeting (no alumni selected for Hall of Fame induction in 2025). Further communication with Alumni Committee chair to discuss alumni outreach in 2025.
